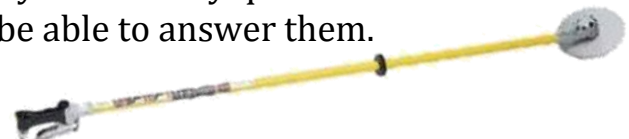
A Fairmont Impact Wrench
